Dear Parents & Carers,

This week we held our Semester 2 Student Led Conferences. This provides our students with an opportunity to share their learning and accomplishments with their families. If you were unable to attend the conferences I encourage you to connect with your child's teacher before the end of the term. Prior to the conferences I was able to speak with many students who shared their learning with me and I was extremely impressed. All our students strive to achieve their personal best and we as a school we are extremely proud of them.

On Wednesday all staff participated in a Professional Learning Day which focused on writing delivered by Lisa Keskinen. Writing is a curriculum focus this year and as we acknowledge our progress in writing, we are always striving to see continued improvement in Teacher Effectiveness and Student Achievement Data. From our new learnings, staff will work collaboratively to identify which adjustments to include into our explicit delivery of writing.

This Thursday and Friday Lisa will work with different cohorts of teachers to model exemplar writing lessons. This opportunity allows teachers to view explicit practices in actions, ask clarifying questions and seek immediate feedback.

On Sunday, a large cohort of Year 6 students leave for the annual Year 6 Interstate Camp. This is an opportunity for students to engage in learning outside of the classroom environment and in a completely different context and environment. We look forward to hearing of their exciting adventures.

Thank you to the parents who completed the 1:1 iPad Learning Program Survey. The feedback was shared at our monthly Board meeting last Wednesday. The School Board unanimously passed a motion to extend this valuable learning program. In 2020 Bakewell Primary will implement two iPad Learning Programs:

Program 1 – Year 1 to Year 3
Program 2 – Year 4 to Year 6

Further information will be sent out to all parents at the beginning of Term 4.

Also discussed at previous School Board meetings was the topic of *Parent Representation on the School Board*. On Monday an electronic survey was sent out to all parents/carers in regards to the number of parents on the Bakewell School Board. I encourage you complete this very short survey.

I am very pleased to inform you that in Term 4 we will be trialling a Homework Centre at Bakewell. This new initiative will be available for any student in Year 3 to Year 6. Homework Centre will run on a Monday afternoon from 2.30pm – 3.45pm. There will be 22 available places and parents will be required to enrol students via the online booking system. Students will be provided with a healthy afternoon snack prior to the commencement of the Homework Centre. Mrs Drysdale is the Homework Centre Leader and students will be working in C9. Please look out for further communication next week.

I look forward to connecting with you all over the next two weeks either before or after school, at assemblies or please pop into my office for a chat.

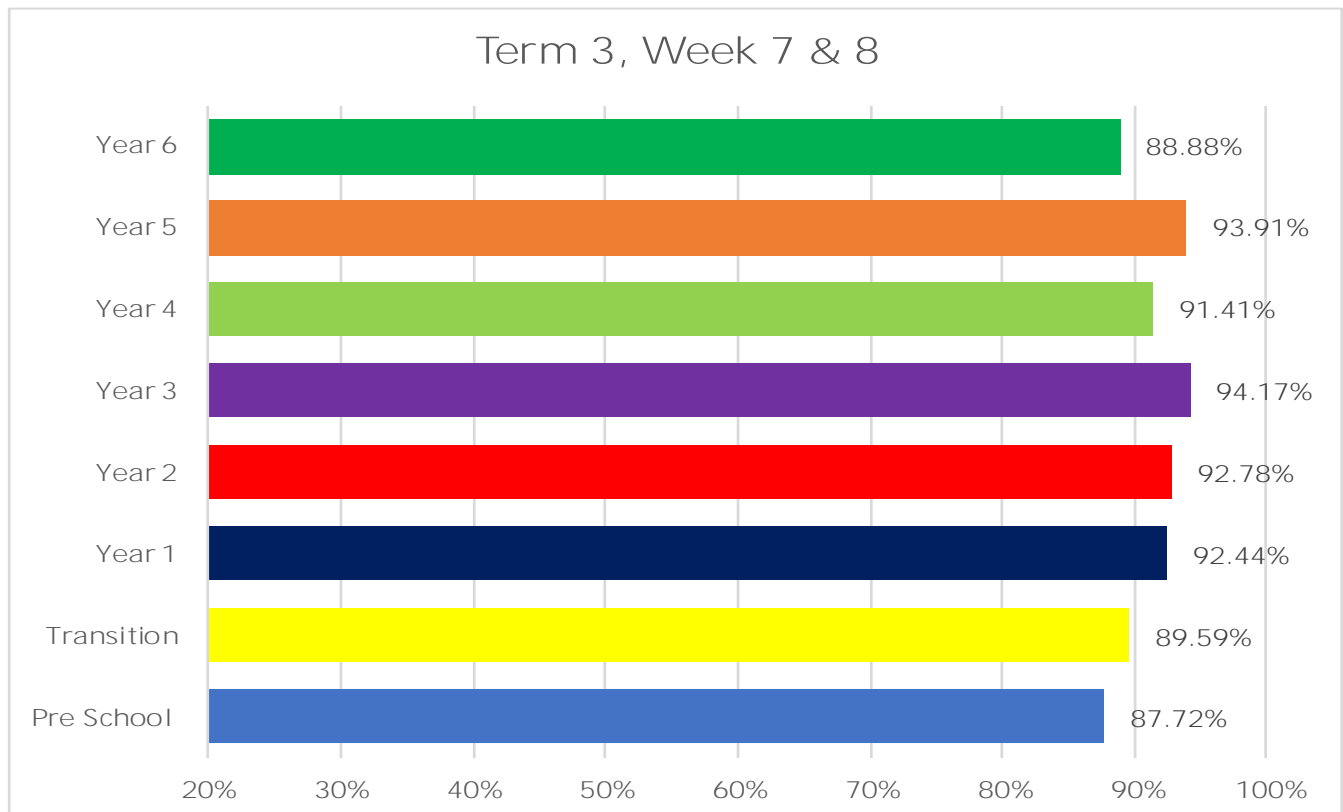
