Dear Parents & Carers,

Year 6 Camp

In Week 10, Term 3, 77 of our Year 6 students participated in the annual Year 6 Interstate Camp to Sydney and Canberra. Students were given the opportunity to participate in a variety of educational programs with a focus on Australia's history, culture, heritage and democracy.

Students had a fantastic time visiting many exciting attractions including Parliament House, the Australian War Memorial, Questacon, The Royal Australian Mint and the High Court of Australia.

The Australian Government recognises the importance of all young Australians being able to visit the national capital as part of their Civics and Citizenship education. To assist families in meeting the cost of the excursion the Australian Government contributes funding of \$340 per student under the Parliament and Civics Education Rebate program towards those costs. The rebate is paid directly to the school upon completion of the excursion. We thank the program for their support in assisting our Bakewell students to attend the Year 6 Interstate camp.



Curriculum Spotlight: Mathematics

Year 3 students have been investigating money during Maths lessons. They have developed their understanding of counting on and counting back strategies to assist them to count values of money and give change to the nearest 5 cents. Students have been given opportunities to use hands on materials to support their understanding and bring their learning to life.



Students in Year 3 have also been exploring grid maps and building their understanding of coordinates. Students were given the opportunity to show their learning by creating their own **"Shark Island"** using the app Pages. They were inspired after a visit from a shark in their classroom through the use of Augmented Reality.



Australian Mathematics Competition (AMC)

At the beginning of Term 3, selected students from Years 5 & 6 participated in the Australian Mathematics Competition (AMC) organised by the Australian Maths Trust Organisation. The students were required to independently answer 30 problem solving questions which ranged in difficulty.
